Please note: Due to changes in course hours and workload, Year 11 students will complete ten Statements of Attainment (SoA) in 2025, held over two lines for the whole year, and will earn 33 TCE points. Students will gain six credit transfers for further study in beauty qualifications at TAFE.

In the following year, Year 11 students will have the opportunity to complete the remaining five units to obtain the full certificate. The remaining five units will be taught over one line for a whole year, resulting in 25 TCE points. The complete qualification consists of 15 units, with a total course load of 580 hours, earning 58 TCE points. Highlighted units will be offered in 2026 for Year 11 students who wish to complete the whole qualification.

\* Current Year 12 students must be enrolled in the additional Year 12 class, which is held on line 2, to obtain the full certificate qualification.
